Are you a patient with wound healing problems (or a carer for someone with wound healing problems)?

If so, we would like to hear from you.

The National Wound Care Strategy Programme (NWCSP) has been set up by the NHS to improve care for people with:

- Pressure ulcers
- Leg and foot ulcers
- Open surgical wounds

To improve care, we need to involve people with experience of wound healing problems to make sure their views are considered in the NWCSP proposals.

The NWCSP Patient and Public Voice Forum is an online register of patients and carers who have said that the NWCSP can contact them to seek their views.

The NWCSP sends out newsletters and information to those registered with the Forum and asks for feedback. Communication is usually via email but there may be some opportunities to attend face-to-face events or webinars. There is no obligation to give feedback or attend any events.
